





An Update on COVID-19 in Chile

More than 25 million vaccines have been administered, with 84% of the target population completing the process.




COVID-19 Vaccine Doses per Supplier: Received & Pending






COVID-19 Cases in Chile



The fall in cases continues to support a gradual relaxation of mobility restricting measures; as of August 23th, 2021, no commune is in lockdown. On the other hand, almost a 50% of the population has reached the highest degree of mobility contemplated in the "paso a paso" plan

Share of Population per Phase People, Data through August 23rd.


Nationwide Mobility

Percent deviation with respect to pre-Covid levels




With fewer ICU patients and cases falling, critical bed capacity has moderated.

Critical beds




ICU patients have declined significantly over the last week across age groups. The average age of ICU patients continues to gradually increase.
