

An Update on COVID-19 in Chile

More than 48.5 million vaccines have been administered, with 90.6% of the target population completing the process (80.4% in the population under 18 years and 93.2% in the population over 18 years). Chile stands out for being the country with the largest share of population vaccinated with booster doses, reaching 72 per 100 inhabitants. In total, 12.9 million booster doses have been administered. Chile has begun the 4th dose vaccination process, starting with the immunocompromised population and healthcare workers.




Percent of Total Population, as of February 28, 2022.





PCR Test Positivity Rate Data through February 6th.




Currently, 69.1% of the national population is in Paso 3 (Step 3) and 30.8% of its population is in Paso 2 (Step 3).




ICU patients have slightly increased, critical bed capacity has moderated.


