


An Update on COVID-19 in Chile

More than 47.8 million vaccines have been administered, with 90.2% of the target population completing the process (78.8% in the population under 18 years and 93.0% in the population over 18 years). Chile stands out for being the country with the largest share of population vaccinated with booster doses, reaching 70 per 100 inhabitants. In total, 12.8 million booster doses have been administered. Chile has begun the 4th dose vaccination process, starting with the immunocompromised population, healthcare workers and population over 55 years old.



Chile has received more than 52.3 million vaccines, mostly from SINOVAC and Pfizer-BioNTech.



Currently, 69.7% of the national population is in Paso 3 (Step 3) and 30.3% of its population is in Paso 2 (Step 3).




ICU patients have increased, critical bed capacity has increased as well to face more patients.


COVID-19 related DeathsPeople, Data through February 17th.



ICU patients have mantained during the last week in all age groups. The average age of ICU patients has stabilized.


ICU patients by Age Group in Chile
