


An Update on COVID-19 in Chile


More than 22 million vaccines have been administered, with 68% of the target population completing the process.





Chile has received more than 25 million vaccines, with supply mainly coming from SINOVAC and Pfizer-BioNTech.

COVID-19 Vaccine Doses per Supplier: Received & Pending











The fall in cases has allowed for a gradual relaxation of mobility measures; as of July 1st, 2021, roughly 18.4% of the nation's population will be in lockdown.


Share of Population per Phase

COVID-19 related Deaths



The increase in ICU patients has concentrated in the under 39 years of age group, although other age groups have also increased recently. The average age of ICU patients has stabilized in recent weeks.


ICU patients by Age Group in Chile
