

## PENSION RESERVE FUND

Monthly Executive Report as of November, 2017

## I. Market Value as of November, 2017

The market value of the Pension Reserve Fund (PRF) totaled US\$9,941.89 million at the end of the month. It changed due to: (i) accrued interests of US\$17.41 million, (ii) capital gains on investments of US\$119.33 million and (iii) administrative, custody and other costs of US\$0.32 million.



## II. Return as of November, 2017

The monthly return in US dollars was 1.39%. This is decomposed in the return of the Sovereign and Government Related Bonds, 1.49%, Inflation Indexed Sovereign Bonds, 1.63%, Corporate Bonds, 0.50%, and Equities, 1.99%. The returns of the fixed income portfolios were explained jointly by the returns in local currency, and also by the movements of the currencies in which the instruments are invested with respect to the US dollar. This impact was positive for both the Sovereign and Corporate bond portfolio. The return of the equity portfolio was explained by the return in local currency, with a positive impact of the movements of the currencies. In pesos, the monthly return of the fund was 2.34%. Finally, the fund accumulated during the year a return of 9.87% in dollars and 5.77% in pesos, while the annualized return since inception was 3.84% and 5.55% respectively.

Returns for periods of more than one year are compound annualized rates while those for less than a year correspond to the change as seen in the stated period. With a view to meeting high standards of transparency and providing a better assessment of the gains or losses on investments, the Ministry of Finance discloses the fund's return in different time horizons and currencies. With respect to the horizon, it is important to note that, in keeping with the medium- and longterm investment policy, the return assessment should focus on that period, disregarding fluctuations that may occur monthly or quarterly. With regard to returns expressed in different currencies, the return in US dollars allows for an assessment which is more in line with the investment policy given that the fund's resources are wholly invested abroad and in foreign currency. The return in Chilean pesos is also disclosed. This return reflects changes in the peso-dollar exchange rate and, therefore, may experience greater fluctuations. Finally, as with any investment, returns obtained in the past do not guarantee future positive results.
