١. Market Value as of October, 2020


The market value of the Pension Reserve Fund (PRF) totaled US\$9,614.03 million at the end of the month. It changed due to: (i) accrued interests of US\$10.67 million, (ii) capital losses on investments of US\$58.43 million and (iii) administrative, custody and other costs of US\$0.96 million.

(US\$ million)





Investments in US Agencies MBS and High Yield Bonds started on January 22nd 2019 as part of the new investment policy defined at the end of 2017.
Investment in Governign Bills and Bonds started on October 1st 2020.
Investment in Governinent Related Bonds started in January 2012.

II. Return as of October

The net return in US dollars was -0,52% in the month. This is broken down into -0,78% for the Long Term Investment portfolio (LTIP) and 0,01% for the Short Term Investment Portfolio (STIP). At the same time, the LTIP return is brown down into the return of the Sovereign and Government Related Bonds, 0.14%, Inflation Indexed Sovereign Bonds, 0.04%, US Agencies MBS, 0.01%, Corporate Bonds, -0.06%, High Yield Bonds, -0.17%, and Equities, -2.62%. The STIP return corresponds to a Bills and Bonds portfolio whose return was 0,01%. The monthly return of the fund in pesos was -2.30%. Year to date return was 3.42% in US dollars and 7.01% in pesos, while the annualized return since inception was 3.90% in US dollars and 6.66% in pesos.

Returns for periods of more than one year are compound annualized rates while those for less than a year correspond to the change as seen in the stated period. With a view to meeting high standards of transparency and providing a better assessment of the gains or losses on investments, the Ministry of Finance discloses the fund's return in different time horizons and currencies. With respect to the horizon, it is important to note that, in keeping with the mediumand longterm investment policy, the return assessment should focus on that period, disregarding fluctuations that may occur monthly or quarterly. With regard to returns expressed in different currencies, the return in US dollars allows for an assessment which is more in line with the investment policy given that the fund's resources are wholly invested abroad and in foreign currency. The return in Chilean pesos is also disclosed. This return reflects changes in the pesodollar exchange rate and, therefore, may experience greater fluctuations. Finally, as with any investment, returns obtained in the past do not guarantee future positive results.
