


An Update on COVID-19 in Chile

More than 59 million vaccines have been administered, with 92.6% of the target population completing the process (87.2% in the population under 18 years and 93.9% in the population over 18 years). Chile stands out for being amoung the countries with the largest share of population vaccinated with booster doses, reaching 79.5 per 100 inhabitants. In total, 15.0 million booster doses have been administered. Since the beginning of the 4th dose vaccination program in April 2022, 8.9 million doses have been administered.



Chile has received more than 60.7 million vaccines, mostly from SINOVAC and Pfizer-BioNTech.

COVID-19 Vaccine Doses per Supplier: Received & Pending






During last weeks cases have increased as well as PCR test positivity rates while ICU occupancy levels, deaths and hospital capacity remain at moderate levels.

People (thousands), Data through June 28th.




PCR Test Positivity Rate Data through June 28th.


Share of Population per Phase

Percent deviation with respect to pre-Covid levels





ICU patients have decreased in all age groups during last weeks. The average age of ICU patients has stabilized around 68 years. .


ICU patients by Age Group in Chile People, Data through June 27th.
